

AUDUBON PHOTOGRAPHY AWARDS

2019 CALL FOR ENTRIES: DEADLINE APRIL 8, 2019

MAIL-IN ENTRY FORM—PRINTS ONLY!

Please enter only prints no smaller than 5x7 inches and no larger than 8x10 inches. No digital files saved onto CDs, DVDs, or any other media will be accepted via this entry method. Each photo may be entered in only one category; to enter two categories (for example, Amateur plus Plants for Birds) please fill out separate entry forms for each. Your name, contact information (address, phone number, email address*) and entry category must be on the back of each print. Information about the image may be entered in the space below or typed on a separate sheet and included with the entries. Contest begins January 7, 2019, and ends April 8, 2019. Mailed entries must be postmarked by April 8, 2019 and received no later than April 15, 2019. Prints will not be returned so make sure you have the original negative, slide, digital file, or duplicate print for your own records. You can mail prints in multiple batches as long as (i) all entries are postmarked by April 8, 2019 and received no later than April 15, 2019, (ii) each submission includes a copy of this mail entry form, and (iii) the back of each print contains the information requested above. Failure to follow these requirements may result in disqualification.
